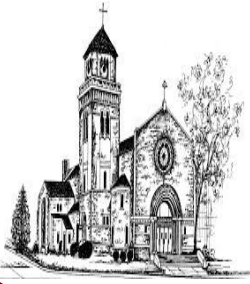

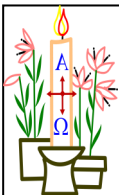

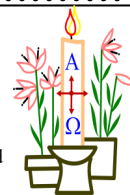
The **deadline** for the Mass Intention to appear in the bulletin is every **Tuesday by 3pm.**

The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on the 2nd and 4th Sundays in English and 1st Sunday in Creole at 1:45pm of each month.

Baptisms at St. Laurence Worship Site

The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on the 3rd Sunday of each month for English & Spanish.

Parents and/or legal guardians must call the parish offices to make appointment to see Clergy for an interview. At the interview, parents must present the child's original birth certificate (not a copy) and attend the instructions prior to the ceremony. The God-Parents MUST be fully initiated Practicing Catholics and have proof to show it via Sponsor letter from the church they are registered at or other religious notarized documentation. Children 7 years old and above should register for Religious Education classes.

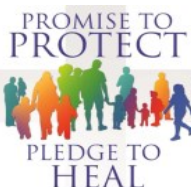
PLEASE REMEMBER TO USE YOUR PARISH ENVELOPES.
